Nine museum exhibitions anchor this year's festival; including a presentation at the Museum of Art called Louis Vuitton: A Passion for Creation (opens May 22). Meanwhile, the Heritage Museum is mounting The Golden Age of Couture: Paris and London 1947-1957 (opens May 30), drawing from the extensive collection of the Victoria and Albert Museum. Fashion by designers such as Cristobal Balenciaga, Christian Dior, Pierre Balmain, Hubert de Givenchy, Norman Hartwell and Hardy Amis will grace over 100 mannequins for a total of 300 displays, making this the biggest haute couture exhibition to ever show in Hong Kong.
